

## Reupholstery Services By Toscano Interiors

Reupholstery is like surgery...no really -- the furniture is stripped down to the frame, then rebuilt, which explains the project's cost. However, you get a "new" piece of furniture as a result. Keep in mind the original piece you brought in will never be the same. While we do our best to make each piece original, we do all of our upholstery by hand, no machines. We cannot replicate what is done in a factory, no matter how hard we try or how much you pay.

### Fabric-

We carry Greenhouse Fabrics in our showroom, with over 5,000 fabric choices. We do not warranty our reupholstery unless you are using Greenhouse fabric for your project. With that being said, here are some important tips for fabric.

The weight of the fabric depends on where and how the piece will be used. Furniture for the bedroom doesn't need to be heavy-duty, but [living room furniture](#) does. Non-upholstery-weight fabric works for a purely decorative piece.

- Take a look at the back of your fabric swatch for the Weisenbeck rating. The rating is determined by an abrasion resistance test; a machine rubs the fabric and keeps track of the number of rubs before the fabric is worn through. A heavy-duty rating translates to 30,000 double rubs. The Weisenbeck rating is most commonly used for commercial fabrics.
- Take home a fabric sample and tuck it in existing furniture to see if you like it. Ask to borrow a bolt or a large hanging sample to cover as much of the piece as possible. Live with it for a few days before making your decision.
- Choose a fabric that will truly update the piece, not just copy the look it had before.
- Fabric may shed since it is new and we are cutting the fabric by hand. DO NOT pull on the strings or pulls. Either allow these pieces to fall off naturally or bring the piece back within the warranty time frame, and we will be happy to fix the piece.

Our upholstery services are warrantied for 1 year. This does not include any repair or modifications made (will be in writing on original contract) after pick up or final delivery of your pieces.
